Dunes Chardonnay Pinot Noir NV <i>Regional</i> The palate is fruit driven and fresh, with added layers of cream and softness from the secondary fermentation and time on tirage lees. This wine is fresh and balanced, with lingering flavours and great mouthfeel.	7.00	28.00
Jansz Premium Non Vintage Rose NV <i>Tasmania</i> This wine is rich with the creaminess of the mousse while the Pinot contributes strawberry notes that fill the palate. The fruit flavours give length to the wine and fresh natural acid provides balance and a refreshing finish.	9.50	38.00
Pirie Estate NV <i>Tasmania</i> Aromas of nutty lemon tart are balanced by careful use of oak and significant malo-lactic characters, both of which also contribute to the textural complexity of the palate which displays lemon butter and butterscotch.	-	42.00
Seppelt Salinger <i>Victoria</i> Complex brioche, yeast and nutty nuances combined with delicate lemon citrus aromas. Initial flavours The wine displays great length and elegance that supports a creamy mid-palate with a crisp and refreshing finish.	-	54.00
Pol Roger Brut Non Vintage NV <i>Epernay, France</i> The "White Foil" blend contains approximately one third of each three grape varieties of Champagne. Yalumba Y Series Unwooded Chardonnay <i>Barossa, SA</i> It has spicy and tropical aromas of melon, fig, pineapple and musk with lifted citrus zest. Lingering melon and peach flavours are complemented by a rich creamy texture – finishing with a refreshing lemon tang.	\$6.00	\$24.00
Peter Lehmann Chardonnay <i>Barossa, SA</i> A delicate pale lemon colour, it shows fresh white peach, a hint of fig and some barrel complexity on the nose. It is a beautifully balanced and restrained wine with excellent soft fruit definition; a stylish and elegant face of Chardonnay.	\$7.00	\$28.00
Wirra Wirra Scrubby Rise Unwooded Chardonnay <i>McLaren Vale, SA</i> Tangy melon and citrus fruit flavours with nutty yeast lees characters contributing to a textured mid palate. There are also some mineral notes and firm acidity that emphasize the freshness of the wine and crisp finish.	-	\$30.00
Yalumba Chardonnay - Wild Ferment <i>Eden Valley, SA</i> Pale gold in colour, with a light green hue. A complex nose offers aromas of lifted figs, peach, lemon and fragrant nutmeg oak. The palate has depth and complexity with flavours of stone fruit, while a creamy long texture is enhanced by the layers developed from the 'wild' ferment.	\$8.00	\$32.00
Coldstream Hills Chardonnay <i>Yarra Valley, Vic</i> Attractive citrus characters of grapefruit and lemon pith with underlying quince and stonefruit dominate the bouquet. Redbank The Long Paddock Sauvignon Blanc <i>King Valley, Vic</i> Displays a complex aroma showing lifted varietal fruits of peach and melon with some citrus notes. This is complemented by integrated French oak and creamy notes from malolactic fermentation. The balanced and mouthfilling palate is driven by fresh fruits and given layers of complexity from the oak and malolactic, finishing with toast and creaminess.	\$6.50	\$26.00
Giesen Estate Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc <i>Marlborough, NZ</i> Lifted, fresh and vibrant aromas of sweet gooseberry and dried cut grass with a distinctive herbal note. Classic nettle and gooseberry flavours combine with dry, citrus flavours on a medium bodied palate. Focused acidity provides length and zest to the finish.	-	\$35.00
Palliser Estate Pencarrow Sauvignon Blanc <i>Martinborough, NZ</i> Very intense nose of classic herbs and hints of tropical fruits, passionfruit and tamarillo. It is vibrant and fresh with expansive flavours. Its rich mid palate has a seamless juicy texture. Pewsey Vale Riesling <i>Eden Valley, SA</i> A rich and intensely flavoured wine. Pale straw in colour with green hues it has intense classic fruit aromas of limes and lemons, with a hint of overlaying dried herb. The palate shows great length and depth with limes, dried herbs and a hint of tropical fruit. The wine finishes with a soft natural acidity which balances the flavour intensity beautifully.	\$8.00	\$32.00
Forest Hill Boobook Sauvignon Blanc Semillon <i>Great Southern, WA</i> Brilliant light straw in colour. Lifted aromas of white nectarine, guava fruit and pear with fresh hints of lemon blossom and fresh cut grass. Fresh, vibrant palate with flavours of lemon zest, pear, guava and kiwi fruit carrying through to a generous finish of cut grass and mineral notes.	\$7.50	\$30.00

Vasse Felix Classic Dry White <i>Margaret River, WA</i> The palate is zesty and vibrant, with fresh fruit sweetness adding a juicy succulence to the pure fruit characters. Coldstream Hills Pinot Noir <i>Yarra Valley, Vic</i> Medium bodied in style with fine chalky tannins and great texture. Dark fruit characters are evident with underlying savouriness and toasty oak.	-	\$52.00
Palliser Estate Pencarrow Pinot Noir <i>Martinborough, NZ</i> Deep red colour. Ripe intense red and dark berry fruit aromas and subtle oak. The taste is of concentrated ripe red and dark fruits and soft fine grained tannins. In the mid palate the fruit sweetness is seductive and the taste impression finishes with fine texture and long persistence of pinot noir flavours.	\$9.00	\$36.00

Smith & Hooper Merlot <i>Wrattonbully, SA</i> The nose is typical of Merlot with savoury, cedar notes and highlights of violets. It also has oak flavours, which meld well with plums and berry fruits. Devils Lair Fifth Leg <i>Margaret River, WA</i> Freshly muddled lime sits in the background. A generous palate thanks to the extended maturation on lees. Intense lychee and passionfruit finishes with a crisp apple crush.	-	\$32.00

Yalumba 'The Scribbler' Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz <i>Barossa, SA</i> This wine is full depth red in colour with purple hues, displaying an aroma of brooding Barossa Cabernet with dark berried fruits, hints of mint and leafiness. The palate is full and stylish showing Shiraz sweetness and plumminess, but finishing with long fine tannins.	\$8.00	\$32.00

Penfolds Tumberumba Chardonnay <i>Adelaide Hills, SA</i> An extremely elegant wine and a wonderful expression of cool climate chardonnay. Vibrant white stone fruit flavours combine beautifully with almost nougat like flavours on the mid palate. A wine with incredible structure; highlighted by the soft, refreshing acidic backbone that runs a core through the wine and the perfectly balanced long, lingering finish.	-	65.00
Howard Park Chardonnay <i>Margaret River, WA</i> The palate is tightly structured with clean acidity and a fresh vibrant mouthfeel. The oak is complementary to the wine with subtle nutty and savoury characters.	-	58.00
Yalumba 'The Menzies' Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Coonawarra, SA</i> The Menzies' the wine opens with a full berry attack building to a round full mid palate of hint and oak. The wine is full bodied with great length given by soft, velvety tannins.	-	65.00
Yalumba 'The Octavius' Old Vine Shiraz - Barossa <i>Barossa, SA</i> Soft, velvety and sumptuous, the palate is a voluptuous concoction of blackberries, cherries, dark chocolates and creamy vanilla oak, all framed by tight knit tannins. The length is remarkable and the balance exceptional.	-	120.00
Yalumba 'The Signature' Cabernet & Shiraz - Barossa <i>Barossa, SA</i> The nose shows lifted florals, violets and choc mints. The palate is brooding and serious with dark chocolate hazelnuts and warm generosity. The Signature finishes with long fine powdery tannins.	-	68.00
Penfolds St Henri <i>Barossa, SA</i> Medium full bodied with an acid tannin conveyance propelling flavour to the back palate. Balanced yet taut with a continuum of flavours - sarsaparilla, beetroot, lemon, blackcurrant. Nutmeg, red liquorice and pomegranate jump to the fore while juniper, bay leaf and menthol linger on the finish.	-	110.00
Peter Lehmann Stonewell Shiraz <i>Barossa, SA</i> Dense black centre with a deep garnet rim. The nose shows lashings of dark plums and chocolate with hints of mint. A wine of great dignity, its structure is superbly taut, with intense depth of fruit reined in by the firm tannins. As befits a wine made in strictly limited quantities, this is a wine for posterity and may be cellared with confidence.	-	90.00
Kooyong Pinot Noir <i>Mornington Peninsula, Vic</i> Vibrant raspberry and black cherry aromas. Subtle savoury characters of forest floor and poached pear enhance the complexity of the wine. A fine and very long palate. Rich red and black fruits predominate with substantial, but elegantly poised tannins driving the palate.	-	70.00
