



Yorkeys Knob Boating Club

Yorkeys Knob Boating Club is a Private Club with various levels of membership. Members and guests are entitled to use the club facilities at any time (within licensing hours / opening hours). Visitors to the club are welcome, however they must abide by the clubs behaviour and dress codes, as well as various laws imposed on clubs by government agencies.

House Rules

1. The club has the right to refuse entry to any person at any point.
2. Dress Rules as displayed at the entrance to the club will be enforced, shirts are available at reception if required. If a guest is deemed not to reach the dress regulations in any way they will be asked to leave the club and can return when dressed appropriately.
 - a. Not Permitted Any Time
 - i. Training Apparel
 - ii. Football Jerseys
 - iii. Men's Headwear
 - iv. Faded or Frayed Clothing
 - v. Soiled, Torn or Dirty Clothing
 - vi. Bare Feet
 - vii. Singlets
 - viii. Swimwear
 - ix. Leotards
 - b. Not Permitted after 7pm
 - i. General Working Cloths
 - ii. Tracksuits or tracksuit style apparel
 - iii. Exercise clothing including stabbies or boxer style shorts
3. All visitors and guests must sign in at reception. Any guest or visitor found in the club that has not signed in will be asked to do so. If a guest or visitor refused to sign in they will be asked to leave the club.
4. Any guest, visitor or member exhibiting behaviour that is deemed offensive by any staff member or other guests will be asked to leave the club.
5. Any guest, visitor or member deemed to be intoxicated will not be served alcohol, this is the law as per Liquor Licensing. Management will support staff on any decision relating to members or visitors having alcohol refused.
6. Any person found drinking alcohol after they have been refused service will be asked to leave the club.
7. Children are to be accompanied by parents at all times, unless in the children's play room or playground.
8. Parents who do not control their children, and are creating a disturbance will be asked to leave the club.

9. Children must leave the premises by 10:30pm unless special permission has been given.
10. No dogs or other animals to be on or in club premises, other than guide or registered assistance dogs.
11. The gaming room (pokies) is off limits to under age members, guests or visitors.
12. Under no circumstances will any underage person be served alcohol.
13. Staff have the right to ask any person at point to produce valid identification for age reasons, this is the law. Valid identification consists of the following,
 - a. Drivers License
 - b. 18+ Card
 - c. Passport
 - d. Victorian Key Pass
14. Under no circumstances is any underage person allowed to consume alcohol, even if the parents are present.
15. Underage persons can order from the bar, however they will only be served non alcoholic drinks.
16. Footwear must be worn by everyone at all times when in the club.
17. No-smoking is permitted in any area except the designated smoking area.
18. Take Away alcohol is available for purchase from opening time until Mid Night only.
19. All Take Away alcohol must be removed from the club no later than 12:30am. No take away alcohol can be consumed on premise.
20. No alcohol is allowed to be brought into the club, with out prior approval by the General Manager.
21. No food is allowed to be brought into the club, with out prior approval by the Club Manager.
22. Before any payout is made on the pokies, Staff must verify the persons status ie. Member / guest / visitor. All guests and visitors must have the blue sign in slip with them, or the payout will not be issued, under QOGR Rules and Regulations.
23. Staff have the right to ask any person to show a valid member card at any point if a discount is requested. Any member not showing the card on request by staff will not receive a discount.
