OFFICIAL RULES

Fishing Area: This is an open ocean tournament, except those prohibited by legislation ie. Green Zones.
Anglers: There is a limit to 6 anglers on any boat, however minimum is 2 adults per boat.
Line & Equipment: There is no limit on the line class an angler wishes to use. All fish must be caught using a hook or hooks attached to a conventional fishing line eg. monofilament, braid etc. No electric reels permitted.
Tournament Hours: Boats may start fishing from 9.00pm on Friday 2nd, with stop fishing at 12.00pm Sunday 4th. Weigh in Sunday 14th 12pm - 2pm. Boats may depart any time after the tournament briefing.
Briefing: There will be a Captains briefing on Friday 2nd, at 6:30pm at YKBC. At least one representative from each boat/team must be present. The rules of this tournament may be amended verbally or in writing at the time of the meeting. Anglers are responsible for being well informed of all rules.
Eligible Fish: The only eligible fish are Coral Trout, Red Emperor and Nannygai. The Mystery target fish will be announced at the briefing.
Prizes: Any prizes not claimed (won) may be used as door prizes, Juniors cannot win senior prizes, juniors must be 16 or under on the day of the competition. Junior catches can contribute to Champion Boat - heaviest combined 3.
Scoring: All fish must be weighed on the certified scale at the official weigh in station, in the presence of the boat / team entering the fish. Tournament winners may be subjected to any equipment inspection or test. All fish must be weighed by 2pm Sunday afternoon, no fish will be accepted after this time unless special permission has been granted. There will be a 10% allowance for gilled or gutted fish.
Communications: The tournament committee will monitor channel 81.
Weather Conditions: In the event of unsafe weather conditions, the tournament committee may choose to postpone the tournament until a later date. Captains are ultimately responsible for their crew and should make the decision as to safe sea conditions. The standard fallback date is 1 week after the scheduled event.
Protests: Any protests concerning the conduct of an angler or rule violations must be filed in writing with the tournament committee no later than 2.00 p.m. on the day of final weigh in.
Awards: Tournament winners will receive all prizes and be paid by cheque, which will be presented at the presentation dinner. Only 1 major prize can be won by any angler, this does not include lucky door prizes. In the event of a tie in weight, the winner will be determined by the earliest weigh in time.
Refunds: No refunds will be given.
Release of Liability: It is expressly understood that all participants in the YKBC Sportfishing Classic enter at their own risk and that YKBC Inc or their officers and directors and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operations of the tournament, or any sponsor of the tournament shall be exempt from any liability for slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury or death suffered by any participant, entrant, sport-fisherman or their companions, boat captains, mates, crew members, guests, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament. **Tournament Committee decision is final on all matters, no correspondence will be entered in to.**
Registration: All registration must be completed by 6.00pm Friday, 2nd of Aug, by registering on the entry form, the angler agrees to follow the above tournament rules and that the tournament and/or it's sponsors may use without payment or restriction any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. Captains are required to sign their entry form as certification that they have read and agreed to abide by all rules and the above liability release. The Captain is responsible for ensuring all anglers and crew are compliant with the rules.
