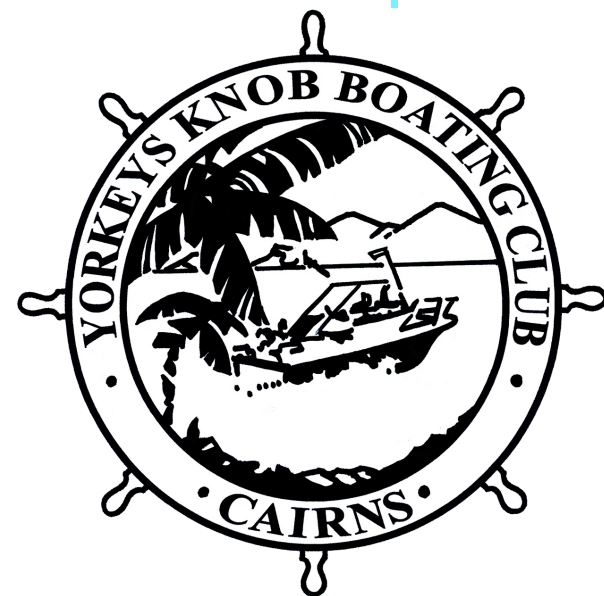

## Yorkeys Knob Sportfishing Club

### Wahi Wahi

**Registration & Fees:** Each boat/team must have a minimum of 2 adult anglers. All registration fees must be paid in full, via “trybooking” no later than 4pm Friday the 15th January 2021. Go to ykbc.com, divisions, fishing club and click on the registration for Wahi Wahi. Alternatively go to Yorkeys Knob Sportsfishing Club on Facebook and click on our events. Late fees apply (\$50 per angler) All anglers must be a current member of Yorkeys Knob Boat Club. (min \$5) Fishing club memberships available from \$70 which includes QGFA membership.

**Earlybird Entry:** Register & pay by 6pm Friday January 8th, to go into draw to win back your entry fee. Entry fees will be re-reimbursed if you decide not to fish. The club must be notified before 6pm Friday 15th January.

**Type of Tournament:** This is a boat / team tournament with individual categories for juniors, no changes are permitted in registered anglers after the conclusion of the Rear Commodore’s Briefing.

**Line:** Open line class. No electric reels permitted.

**Rear Commodore’s Briefing:** There will be a briefing on Friday January 15th, at 6.30 p.m. at YKBC. At least one representative from each boat/team must be present, failure to attend briefing may result in disqualification. The rules of this tournament may be amended verbally or in writing at the time of the meeting. Anglers are responsible for being well informed of all rules.

**Eligible Fish:** The only eligible fish for the Cash Prize, are Wahoo and Mahi Mahi (Dolphin Fish). Fish do not have to go line class in order to be weighed. Only 2 fish per species (2 x Dolphin fish & 2 x Wahoo) can be weighed per boat. Each angler can only weigh a maximum of 1 fish from each species.

**By Catch Category;** This is a separate category. Only 1 fish per species, (Spanish mackerel or yellowfin tuna only) per angler to be weighed in.

**BillFish:** Not eligible in this tournament.

**Weigh in:** All fish must be weighed in edible condition and weighed at the YKBC official weigh station located at the Clubhouse. Weigh station open from 5pm – 7pm Saturday and Sunday. All fish must be presented gutted for weighing. Champion Boat can not win largest wahoo and dolphin fish. Champion boat must catch both species.

**Scoring Overall** Tournament: All entries must be weighed on the certified scale at the official weigh-in location in the presence of the boat/team entering them. Tournament winners may be subject to equipment inspection tests. Any fish may be examined by any means necessary. In the event of a fish being fought after the “stop fishing” announcement, permission to continue the fight must be requested from the tournament committee.

**Communications:** All participating boats must be equipped with a working VHF marine radio or cell phone by prior arrangement only. The tournament committee will monitor VHF channel 81. Official times or special notifications will be announced during the tournament on this channel. No weigh-in statistics will be given over the radio. All boats must participate in the radio scheds, giving their location and the number of fish caught, no sizes or weights are to be given over the radio. Sched times will be 11.05am & 2.05pm.

**Tournament Hours:** Start Fishing 8am on Saturday / 7am Sunday, Stop Fishing 5pm Saturday / 4pm Sunday. Official time for both will be announced over VHF Channel 81. For fish to be counted towards your boats score they need to be weighed before the close of weigh station on the day of capture, unless a vessel is staying out overnight.

**Weather Conditions:** In the event of unsafe weather conditions, the tournament committee may choose to postpone the tournament until a later date.( 1 week) Captains are ultimately responsible for their crew and should make the decision as to safe sea conditions. Tournament fall back dates will be announced at the time.( 1 week)

**Boundaries:** This is an open ocean tournament

**Protests :** Any protests concerning the conduct of an angler or rule violations must be filed in writing with the tournament committee no later than 6.00 p.m. on the day of the alleged violation.

**Awards:** Tournament winners will receive all prizes and be paid by cheque, which will be presented at the awards ceremony. Perpetual trophies to remain at YKBC.

**Ties:** In the event of a tie in weight, the winner will be determined by the earliest weigh in time

**Release of Liability:** It is expressly understood that all participants in the Wahi Wahi Tournament enter at their own risk and YKBC Inc or their officers and directors and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operations of the tournament, or any sponsor of the tournament shall be exempt from any liability for slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury or death suffered by any participant, entrant, sport-fisherman or their companions, boat captains, mates, crew members, guests, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament.

**Tournament Committee decision is final on all matters, there will be no appeals or correspondence.**

**Registration** - By registering on the entry form, the angler agrees to follow the above tournament rules and that the tournament and/or it’s sponsors may use without payment or restriction any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. All anglers are required to sign their entry form as certification that they have read and agreed to abide by all rules and the above liability release. All vessels must present a valid certificate of currency (insurance).
