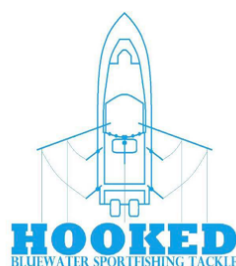


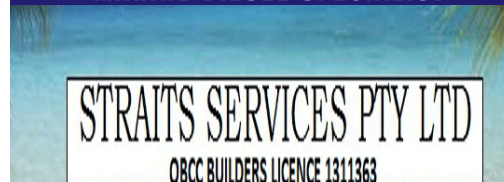

Official Rules

Fishing Area: This is an open ocean tournament, except those prohibited by legislation ie. Green Zones.

Anglers: The maximum amount of anglers is 8 per boat and the minimum is 2 adults per boat.

Line & Equipment: There is no limit on the line class an angler wishes to use. All fish must be caught using a hook or hooks attached to a conventional fishing line eg. monofilament, braid etc. No electric reels permitted. Only anglers over the age of 70 are permitted to use electric reels.

Tournament Hours: As per hours on itinerary.

Briefing: There will be a briefing on Friday 26th, at 6:30pm at YKBC. At least one representative from each boat/team must be present. The rules of this tournament may be amended verbally or in writing at the time of the meeting. Anglers are responsible for being well informed of all rules.

Eligible Fish: Eligible fish as per the species and points list will be provided at the briefing. This is a catch and release fishing competition (no fish will be weighed in). Any disfigured fish submissions will not be accepted. Maximum of 2 fish per species per angler. As this is a catch and release competition fish do not need to be legal size to count towards your score however all undersize fish must be released unharmed.

How to submit your catch: Take a photo of your fish on the official brag mat. The photo needs to clearly show the length of the fish and species. Upload your picture via our YKSFC mobile app for both android and IOS. **All entries must be submitted via the app no later than 9pm Sunday 28th of Feb. No late entries will be counted**

Prizes: Any prizes not claimed (won) may be used as door prizes, Juniors cannot win senior prizes, juniors must be 17yrs or under on the day of the competition.

Communications: The tournament committee will monitor channel 81.

Weather Conditions: In the event of unsafe weather conditions, the tournament committee may choose to postpone the tournament until a later date. Captains are ultimately responsible for their crew and should make the decision as to safe sea conditions. Fallback date for bad weather is 1 week from the original comp date

Awards: Tournament winners will receive prizes which will be presented at the presentation dinner. In the event of a tie in score, the winner will be determined by the earliest submission in time. You must attend the presentation dinner in order to receive a prize.

Refunds: Refunds provided on committee's discretion

Release of Liability: It is expressly understood that all participants in the YKBC Sport Fishing River 2 Reef Shootout enter at their own risk and that YKBC Inc or their officers and directors and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operations of the tournament, or any sponsor of the tournament shall be exempt from any liability for slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury or death suffered by any participant, entrant, sport-fisherman or their companions, boat captains, mates, crew members, guests, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament.

Tournament Committee decision is final on all matters, no correspondence will be entered into.

Registration: All registration must be completed by 5.00pm Friday, 26th of Feb. By registering the angler agrees to follow the above tournament rules and that the tournament and/or it's sponsors may use without payment or restriction any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. By entering the comp all anglers certify that they have read and agreed to abide by all rules and the above liability release.
